HIGHLIGHTS <u>Electrical Safety</u> (Louie) *Don't play on electrical boxes that are in yards. *Power lines are very dangerous, don't go near them! *Don't play around electrical outlets. <u>Water Safety</u> *"Don't Just Pack It, Wear Your Jacket" when you are in a boat or near water. *Swim only in an area with a lifeguard or when a grown-up is watching you. <u>Gun Safety</u> If you see a gun, "Stop, Don't Touch, Leave the Area, Tell an Adult"	HIGHLIGHTS <u>Poison Safety</u> *"If you don't know what it is, stay away". *If you don't know what it is: Don't touch it, Don't taste it, Don't smell it.	HIGHLIGHTS <u>Tornado Safety</u> *Locate a "safe spot" in your home.	HIGHLIGHTS <u>Animal Safety</u> Don't try to touch a wild animal. They may be cute, but stay away. *If a dog chases you or knocks you down, "Be a tree" or "Be a log". Don't run! *Always ask a pet owner's permission before you pet a dog or cat.	HIGHLIGHTS Review safety lessons with your child regularly. Have a safe Summer!

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
