<p><u>HIGHLIGHTS</u></p> <p><u>Electrical Safety (Louie)</u></p> <p>*Don't play on electrical boxes that are in yards.</p> <p>*Power lines are very dangerous, don't go near them!</p> <p>*Don't play around electrical outlets.</p> <p><u>Water Safety</u></p> <p>**"Don't Just Pack It, Wear Your Jacket" when you are in a boat or near water.</p> <p>*Swim only in an area with a lifeguard or when a grown-up is watching you.</p> <p><u>Gun Safety</u></p> <p>*If you see a gun, "Stop, Don't Touch, Leave the Area, Tell an Adult"</p>	<p><u>HIGHLIGHTS</u></p> <p><u>Poison Safety</u></p> <p>**If you don't know what it is, stay away".</p> <p>*If you don't know what it is: Don't touch it, Don't taste it, Don't smell it.</p>	<p><u>HIGHLIGHTS</u></p> <p><u>Tornado Safety</u></p> <p>*Locate a "safe spot" in your home.</p>	<p><u>HIGHLIGHTS</u></p> <p><u>Animal Safety</u></p> <p>*Don't try to touch a wild animal. They may be cute, but stay away.</p> <p>*If a dog chases you or knocks you down, "Be a tree" or "Be a log". Don't run!</p> <p>*Always ask a pet owner's permission before you pet a dog or cat.</p>	<p><u>HIGHLIGHTS</u></p> <p>Review safety lessons with your child regularly.</p> <p>Have a safe Summer!</p>

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
